Εὐαγγέλιον euangelion	“evangel”	good news; gospel	e.g.: “repent and believe in the good news ” (Mk. 1:15)
εὐαγγελίζω euangelizo	“evangelize”	to bring the good news	e.g.: “we bring you good news ” (Ac. 14:15)
εὐαγγελιστῆς euangelistes	“evangelist”	one who gives the good news	e.g.: “do the work of an evangelist ” (2 Tim. 4:5)

3. Read **Hebrews 10:37-39**. Why is the imminent return of Christ for his church a motivation for our evangelism, and why do you think it fails to motivate so many Christians?
4. Read **1 Corinthians 2:1-3**. What advice would you give a Christian who is afraid to talk to friends and coworkers about their need for the gospel?
5. Read **Colossians 4:3-4**. How can you pray for others to be more intentional in their evangelism? How has specifically praying for someone else's evangelism affected yours?
6. Read **Romans 10:1**. Who are some people you know who need to get right with God? What will you do to become more impassioned about seeing them saved?
