Home Group/Study Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the truths we are learning.

Large Group

1. Was there any passage of scripture or statement in the message today that was particularly meaningful or applicable to you?

Small Group

2. Read **Ezekiel 34:11-16** and **John 6:44**. How do these passages about God seeking his people affect the way you view your "decision" to follow Christ?
3. Read **Romans 3:9-20** and **5:7-8**. Why is a sober and honest appraisal of your own sin so important to getting your redemption in perspective?
4. Read **1 Timothy 1:12-17**. When you think of your salvation do you have the same perspective that Paul has in this passage? What can you do to think and react to your salvation the way Paul does here?
5. Read **Psalms 8:3-4**. While this Psalm of David is reflecting on humanity's place in creation, imagine how much more profound it is to add the thought of our costly salvation to this song. With that in mind, utilize this psalm to write out a brief prayer of humble thanksgiving to God.
