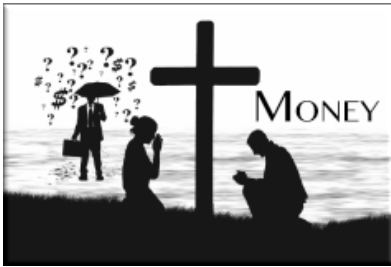

Large Group

1. Was there any passage of scripture or statement in the message today that was particularly meaningful to you?

Small Group

2. Read **James 2:14-15**. The sermons in this series have focused on personal generosity as a demonstration of our faith in Christ and giving to meet the needs of the poor. How generous are you? What are some excuses people give when they are not generous?
3. These messages have focused on giving to meet needs, but giving wisely. How do you make decisions about the recipients of your generosity?
4. Read **Matthew 24:41-46**. Does reading this passage make you rethink the level of your care for others? Though we don't earn heaven by our good works, good works are a demonstration of our faith. How can you grow in this area of maturity?
5. In the previous passage, in verse 46, there are two destinations – eternal punishment or eternal life. How do you respond to people who don't believe in hell?
6. Pastor Marty said "love warns." How can you lovingly warn people about the irreversibility of rejecting Christ?
